Dear Sunday Worshipers,

It has come to our attention that occasionally, proper decorum and keeping within a dignified Worship Service can be superficial in today's technology of ZOOM and FACEBOOK, with most people

being unaware and fully with unintentional expressions that can be visible or overheard.

With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we are asking for the following as guidelines and appropriate protocol during our services:

- Once the service begins with the Prelude and/or the Celebrant's welcome, please make sure your microphone is **mute** at that time, until asked otherwise, such as during the Peace or Prayers of the People. Once the Mass has ended, everyone can participate and resume in fellowship, with microphones being turned back on. Please note that early fellowship is also available prior to the services, starting at 8:40 AM.
- During the Mass, when your microphone is not muted for any reason, try to refrain from any unnecessary conversation, comments or activities that could possibly distract others. Also, make certain that your microphone is muted when singing the hymns virtually during the service.
- Since everyone is being video-recorded during our services, feel free to turn off your camera temporarily, when engaged in any other personal activities during the Mass.
- Always be prayerfully mindful of how our worship, as a whole, is representing our loving, inclusive and faith-filled community to all who are listening and viewing our services on their choice of platform.

Thank you, very much for your greater awareness and complete participation and focus in our Mass.
