#### 1. Pack a Shoebox for a Child in Need

Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child shoebox gifts delight the hearts of boys and girls in more than 100 countries where Samaritan's Purse local partners deliver the boxes along with the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. For some children, it is their first gift ever! Many shoebox recipients also participate in Samaritan's Purse follow-up discipleship program, The Greatest Journey, where they learn to know, grow in, and spread the Good News. Through these exciting evangelism and discipleship efforts, Samaritans Purse sees the multiplication of believers and churches worldwide.

The Outreach Committee is providing "How to pack a shoebox leaflets" and plastic shoe boxes located on the Welcome Table on the church steps. This year, Samaritan's Purse is charging a \$10 shipping fee per

2. Christmas Gifts for Children . . .

Please look for a small table-top Christmas tree in the back of the church with ornaments which indicate the ages of children from Infants to teens. It has been a tradition that our families take the ornaments and provide an age-appropriate gift for that child. The outreach committee will be providing more information about this Family Resource center which assists families with children attending school at two elementary schools in the area. One around the corner to the east and the other two blocks west of the church.

#### Laundry Love

On October 20, 2022, Blessed Sacrament Laundry Love served 50 people, doing 372 loads, spending \$610.50 (7.4 loads/person, \$1.64/load, and \$12.21/person). Many 50 ml. containers of hand sanitizers from the American Legion Placentia Auxiliary were given out, as were many face masks. Free detergent from EarthBreeze.com was used. The Children Learning Center contributed \$20. Blessed Sacrament volunteers Tom Johnson, Marion Lee, and Doug Lee assisted Busy Bee Laundry attendant Maria. Thanks very much to all our supporters and to Doug Lee, our Laundry Love Facilitator!


